## **Availability: Linux Version**

- Linux version currently available on OPN
- Includes database 11g, BIEE 10.1.3.3.2, Hyperion 9.3.1, SOA 10.1.3, Data Integrator 10.1.3.4, Data Miner, Portal 10.1.4, Discoverer 10.1.2.0.2. This upgraded version includes the new Analytic Applications 7.9.5 install.

- Will be available shortly in two versions: Trial version (30 day revolving licence) and fully licensed option (no expiry.
- Will contain the entire BIEE, Hyperion, and BI Applications stack, including windows client development tools (not available in linux version).

# **Getting Started – VMware Config**

- Recommend machines that have at least 3G of RAM with 90G disk. (Note: 64bit linux supports 4G+)
- Do not be doing any other tasks (no other running programs)!
- Recommend VMware Player (latest) or VMware Server (V. 1.07 or 2.0). Note: V 1.07 easier to use.
- Memory set to <u>1.5G</u> on BIC2g:BI, <u>2.3G</u> on BIC2g:EPM. General rule of thumb: reserve <u>at least</u> .5G for your operating system, otherwise reserve the rest for the VM (I.E.: if you have 3G of ram you can adjust the BIC2g:BI up to 2.4G).
- CPU set to **2**. If you only have one CPU this can be changed by editing the .vmx configuration file (look for ncpus setting)
- Network set to <u>bridged</u> for both images.

# **BIC2g:BI - Hyperion**

- All the EPM products have been installed and configured and available for use. Note that EPMA, MDM, FDM, and FM leverage IIS, which is running on Port 80. Weblogic Managed Server (BIEE, ODI) is also running on Port 80 (conflict – both cannot run at the same time).

- 27 IR reports
- 30 WA reports
- 6 PR reports
- Eden Sales and Retail demos
- Essbase components: EDENODS, TBC, ESSFDM, Text, and Essbase server DEMODRIVE. The Essbase applications which can be generated from the operational data sources include EdenGL, TBC and ESSFDM

- SmartSpace Hyperion BIEE BIP Delivers configured.

- RTD: Includes E-Commerce Demo
- **OLAP:** XWeek 2008 hands on lab loaded (includes MV rewrite to cubes, DM schema, etc.)


